The University of Zurich offers a Postdoc position within the University Research Priority Project “Translational Cancer Research”.

Our University Research Priority Project (URPP) “Translational Cancer Research” (www.cancer.uzh.ch) aims to connect basic, translational and clinical cancer research and consists of a consortium of 17 principal investigators and associated members, who are leaders in the field of cancer research.

The project focuses on how exosomes induce changes in premetastatic tissues and how standard therapies including radiotherapy influence these processes.

The successful candidate for this prestigious URPP-fellowship will work in the laboratory of Prof. Dr. Maries van den Broek and collaborate with different URPP members. He/she will be a member of the Institute of Experimental Immunology (www.immunology.uzh.ch), which is located on the Irchel campus of the University of Zurich.

We expect a strong interest in interdisciplinary science and in linking fundamental and clinical research. Candidates should hold a PhD, MD-PhD or equivalent degree in life sciences.
